## DOUGLAS AVENUE DESIGN SERVICES GRANT

### Project Description

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### Rules Governing the “Douglas Avenue Design Services Grant”

1. Eligibility—Only existing buildings within the Douglas Avenue Corridor boundaries will be considered.
2. All façade designs must comply with the Douglas Avenue Design Guidelines.
3. Douglas Avenue BID Board discretion—Applies in approving any grant.
4. Applications—Must be accompanied by current photograph of the building and name & contact information of designer or architect.
5. No middleman role—Under no circumstances will the Douglas Avenue BID Board be considered to be or act as the owner’s agent or as part to any agreements or contracts associated with the Design Services Grant project. The Douglas Avenue BID Board will not have any role or responsibility in evaluating the compliance or application of any governmental codes relating to the proposed design services.
6. Design Services Grant—The purpose of this grant is to provide for design services in support of implementing a professionally designed façade improvement to your building. It is the intention of the program to lead to an actual façade improvement.
7. Payment of grant—Shall be made by Douglas Avenue BID Board directly to the applicant upon submittal of a paid invoice, color rendering of the design and photographs of the completed façade improvement. Said completed façade improvement must be consistent with the proposed design.
8. Approval void—Douglas Avenue BID Board approval of Design Services Grant is valid for 6 months only from the date of the approval letter. If good faith undertaking of the design has not occurred at the end of 6 months, the grant approval automatically becomes void. Re-application for the grant will be considered in such circumstances.
9. Total grant funding is limited to \$9,000.00.
